Waldringfield Wildlife Group Guided Bat Walk - 12th September 2016, meeting at 6.45 pm.



Our guide is Duncan Sweeting from the Suffolk Bat Group. We will be using bat detectors and the walk will start with an introduction to Suffolk Bats and an explanation on how to use the bat detectors.

We will walk, listening to bats flying overhead and Duncan will point out the different species of bats and explain bat behaviour.

The walk will be one hour long and Duncan will answer questions during the walk or at the end of the walk.

There are 13 species of bats in Suffolk out of the 17 species that can be found in the UK. Hopefully, we will hear some of these species in Waldringfield subject to good weather as bats do not fly in heavy rain nor in high winds.

Duncan has worked with bats for over twenty years and he holds three bat licences to enable him to do this work.

Duncan is a committee member of the Suffolk Bat Group and Suffolk Bat Rescue.
