Thursday November 2<sup>nd</sup> at 7.30 pm: Jim Bacon, the weatherman talking about - guess what - the weather. He has agreed to talk to us in return for a healthy contribution to East Anglian Children's Hospice (Treehouse). Let's have a good turn-out and help EACH at the same time.

On Thursday December 7th David Phelan, local historian, will talk on St Audry's, Workhouse to Asylum. This illustrated talk covers the history of St Audry's from 1765, when it was opened as a Workhouse, through to 1993 when it was closed in favour of Care in the Community. David's talk includes an examination of the Victorian attitude to poverty and the effectiveness of various regimes involved in the management of mental ill-health.
