Eastern Angles, our regional touring theatre, are back with a new play, *Booming Voices*, which aims to capture the magic of the Broads and to explore their possible future. Author Ivan Cutting says: It is a follow up to our production of *The Tide Jetty* which was so popular three years ago. This time the setting is one of the most beautiful and vulnerable spots in East Anglia, centring on the story of the fictional Jen, a young student who is shielding in an isolated cottage on the edge of a watery haven and housesitting for a Professor in the US who is investigating the impact of climate change. Together they explore the iconic wildlife and nature of the Broads, showing us just how vulnerable is this seemingly timeless landscape.

With the songs of acclaimed folk musician Jimmy Aldridge, and insights from figures who helped discover the true nature of this wetland paradise (comparable to Ibiza, sang David Bowie), *Booming Voices* promises to be an evening that both prepares us for the future and gives us hope. (The play is thought suitable for 14 plus.)
