

WALDRINGFIELD TENNIS COURT TRUST

REPORT TO THE ANNUAL PARISH MEETING, 9th April, 2013

GENERAL CONDITION

The court is now into its 15th season after total re-construction in 1998. Last year a root barrier was inserted along the south-eastern corner, tree root damage was repaired and the surface painted and re-lined. The cost of the root barrier was £1,855.80 and the court repairs £2,334. This was covered by the County "Sportspace" fund leaving the Tennis Court Trust finances in a good position to cover future work.

The court is now in very good condition and should last another 3 seasons before major re-surfacing becomes necessary, which is likely to cost at least £15,000.

ANNUAL FINANCES

- Income for 2012 (court fees and interest less expenses) was £854 – £183 up on the previous year.
- The total bank balance at the start of the 2013 year was £10,350.15.

COURT FEES

At the Annual General Meeting, the Committee agreed the court fees should remain the same as the previous year which are as follows:
