Dear Parishioner,

Thank you for taking the time to look at my report. I have tried to highlight some of the broad issues, concerns and programs we work on at County level.

Along with the county wide programs worked on in my report, I have used highways locality funds to assist with signage and line painting in Waldringfield and for the design of a footpath to safely enable school access. Highway funds are being held in reserve as I work with the highways team to monitor the flooding along School Lane/Newbourne Road and use if necessary for ditch clearance.

Locality budget funds are committed to help the Parish Council upgrade the Waldringfield play area.

I am also pleased to confirm that funds committed to Suffolk Wildlife Trust for access improvements at Martlesham Wilds have been drawn down. The funds are to support the new footpath works currently underway which include realignment of the footpath, a new footbridge, excavation works and the purchasing, joinery and installation of the viewing platforms.
