

The monthly coffee mornings

These are usually held in the village hall on the first Thursday of each month from 10am-noon and are organised and run by a team of volunteers. They not only provide a valuable social hub for villagers, but they have also attracted people from further afield, who enjoy the friendly atmosphere.

All of the cakes and savouries are homemade, and we are able to cater for those who have special dietary requirements - for example, gluten-free, dairy free, and vegan. We have a selection of teas, and provide decaffeinated tea and coffee too. The coffee mornings have grown and evolved over time. Many are themed, and at times, we have various stallholders in attendance, some from within the village and some from other areas.

Villagers are welcome to have stalls free of charge, but we do tend to ask for a donation of £10 from visitors, depending on sales!

All monies raised from the coffee mornings (following deductions for expenses) are for village hall funds.
